This petition having been heard on 01.03.2025 and the court on the same day passed the following :-

ORDER

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff/petitioner. No caveat reportedly pending. Perused the records. The accompanying affidavit discloses a prima facie case. I am satisfied that if the notice is issued before granting the injunction, the resultant delay would defeat the purpose of granting the injunction. Further I believe that if injunction is not granted irreparable injury will be caused to the plaintiff/petitioner.

Hence, the defendant and any one acting under him is restrained from inducting strangers into the Plaint Schedule Property, cutting and removing the trees standing therein and also from committing any acts of waste over the Plaint Schedule Property, until further orders. Comply with Proviso (a) and (b) to Order 39 Rule 3. Issue notice to the respondent. Return of notice by 17.03.2025.
