ORDER

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff/petitioner. No caveat reportedly pending. Perused the records. The accompanying affidavit discloses a prima facie case. Further I believe that if injunction is not granted irreparable injury will be caused to the plaintiff/petitioner.

Hence, the defendant and any one acting under him is restrained from obstructing the plaintiff from using the plaint item No.3 pathway by any means until further orders. Comply with Proviso (a) and (b) to Order 39 Rule 3. Issue notice to the respondent. Return of notice by 14.11.2024.
