ORDER

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff/petitioner. No caveat is reportedly pending. Perused the records. The accompanying affidavit discloses a prima facie case. I am satisfied that if the notice is issued before granting the injunction, the resultant delay would defeat the purpose of granting the injunction. Further I believe that if injunction is not granted irreparable injury will be caused to the plaintiff/petitioner.

Hence, the defendants and any one acting under them are restrained from reclaiming the item No.3 thodu, causing any obstruction of the free flow of water through the plaint item No.3 thodu until further orders. Comply with Proviso (a) and (b) to Order 39 Rule 3. Issue notice to the respondents. Return of notice by 28.11.2024.
