This case coming on for hearing on this day and the court on the same day passed the following:

ORDER

This case was charge sheeted by the Police Sub Inspector, Aroor Police Station in crime No. 645 of 2025 for the offences punishable U/ss. 296(b), 119(1), 110, 189(2), 191(2), 191(3),190, 115(2) of BNS

2. The prosecution allegation, in brief, is as follows:- Due to prior animosity towards the the defacto complainant and his friends, and with the intention to inflict injury upon them, on 04.08.2025 at 11:15 PM, the 1st accused, an employee of Ezhupunna Palace Bar, verbally abused the defacto complainant and his friends. He then forcefully evicted them from the premises and exhorted other staffs of the Bar to attack them. Subsequently, the 2nd, 4th, and 6th accused persons came outside the bar

armed with iron rods and assaulted the defacto complainant and his friends, pushing them outside the premises. Thereafter, the 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 8th accused persons surrounded and assaulted the defacto complainant and his friends. The 2nd, 4th, and 6th accused persons beat them using iron rods, and specifically, the 2nd accused struck the defacto complainant on the side of his head with an iron rod, thereby causing injury. Had the attack not been obstructed, it could have resulted in the death of the defacto complainant and the accused persons have thereby committed offences punishable under Sections 189(2), 191(3), 191(2), 190, 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), and 110 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

3. The first accused was granted anticipatory bail as per the order of the Honourable Session Court of Alapuzha in CrI. M.C. 1002 of 2025 dated 27.08.2025, and accused 2 to 9 were arrested and remanded on 08.08.2025. Later they were granted bail from this court. Accused 1 to 9 are represented by counsel appointed by them. Copies of the prosecution records were duly furnished to the accused.

4. On a perusal of records, it appear that the offence u/s 110 of BNS alleged against the accused is exclusively triable by the Court of Session. Hence, the case is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha u/s. 232 of

BNSS for trial.

5. Transmit the case records and properties if any, to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha. Accused are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha as and when required. Issue notice to the Public Prosecutor, Alappuzha regarding the factum of committal of the case.
