This case coming on for hearing on this day and the court on the same day passed the following:

ORDER

This case was charge sheeted by the Police Sub Inspector, Muhamma Police Station in crime No.571 of 2024 for the offences punishable U/ss.115(2), 191(2), 296(b) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023

2. The prosecution allegation, in brief, is as follows:- The accused persons, who were travelling in a car bearing Registration No. KL-32T-5314, became enraged when CW1, while riding a motorcycle with CW4 as a pillion rider, allegedly splashed water onto their vehicle. Owing to such animosity, and with a common object, they formed themselves into an unlawful assembly, and in prosecution of the said common object, knowing themselves to be members of

such assembly, on 14.07.2024 at about 7:30 p.m. at Panchayat Ward No. 9, wrongfully restrained CW1, uttered abusive words, and assaulted him by fisting on his abdomen, left shoulder, neck, and hip. When CW2 questioned the said act, the accused persons also assaulted CW2 by kicking him on his face and chest. Thus, the accused persons, in furtherance of their common object, committed the alleged offences under Section 115(2), 191(2), 296(b) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita .

3. The accused surrendered before the Investigating Officer on 18.01.2025 and they were released on bail after recording their arrest. Upon filing of the final report, summons was issued to the accused. They appeared before the Court and were represented by counsel of their choice. Copies of the prosecution records were duly furnished to the accused .

4. Originally, this case was taken on file as C.C. No. 798 of 2024. Charge was framed and summons issued to CW1. There after, on perusal of the records, it is seen that CW1 is a minor against whom the alleged criminal act was committed. Since CW1 is a minor, the matter is triable by the Children's Court. Accordingly, this case has been refiled as C.P. No. 18 of 2026 and is

committed to the Children's Court, Alappuzha, for trial.

5. Transmit the case records and properties if any, to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha. The accused is on bail. He is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha as and when required. Issue notice to the Public Prosecutor, Alappuzha regarding the factum of committal of the case.
