This petition having been finally heard on 30.05.2026
and the court on 01.06.2026 passed the following.

ORDER

This is an application filed by the accused u/s 483 of BNSS.

2. The offences alleged in the case are punishable u/s 8© and 22© of the NDPS Act.
3. The accused is in judicial custody from 07.03.2026.
4. The prosecution opposed the application and filed report.
5. Heard both sides.
6. The prosecution case is that on 07.03.2026 at about 10.45 a.m , the accused was found in possession of 31.8 grams of MDMA near the private bus stand adjacent to Kayamkulam Railway station. Thus the accused is alleged to have committed the aforesaid offence.

7. The allegations levelled against the accused are very serious and the same are prima facie made out from the final report filed in the case. Apart from that the accused was red handed with the contraband. If the petitioner is released on bail there is every chance for him to abscond. It would result in delay of trial. There is every chance for threatening the independent witnesses and to commit similar other offences. So, the release of the accused at this stage is not proper.

8. The period of detention alone is not a relevant criteria to exercise the discretion in favour of the petitioner. The grant of bail to this type of offenders will not be in the best interest of the society. There is nothing to hold that the accused is innocent. No special reason is made out to exercise the discretion in favour of the petitioner. So, the application deserves only a dismissal.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
