This Sessions Case having been finally heard on 26.02.2026 and the court on 11.03.2026 delivered the following:

JUDGMENT

This is a case charge sheeted by the Inspector of Police, Kayamkulam, alleging commission of offence punishable u/s. 302 of the Indian Penal Code against the sole accused.

2. Prosecution case, in brief, is as follows:- CW29, a friend of Ajeesh @Kannan who is the brother of accused, borrowed ₹1½ lakhs from the accused. The said amount was demanded back by the accused and her husband, CW6. Knowing this, Ajeesh reached the rented house of CW29 viz. 'Sreya Bhavanam' '@Arunodayam House' with house No. 96, which is on the north of Pullikkanakku - Thekke Mankuzhy road, east of Pariyarathu Leksham Veedu colony,

Ward No.4, Krishnapuram Panchayath, Pullikkanakku Muri, Krishnapuram Village and picked up quarrel with the accused and CW6 about the demand of money from CW29. Due to this enmity, with intent to murder Ajeesh by stabbing, at 07.30 p.m. on 29.05.2017, the accused who kept the knife at the sit-out of the said house, stabbed behind the chest of Ajeesh which pierced into the lungs, and the arteries towards liver were cut and Ajeesh succumbed to the injuries, thereby, the case.

3. On the basis of the F.I. Statement given by CW1, the FIR was registered by CW79; CWs80 and 81 conducted investigation, and on completion of investigation, CW81 laid the final report before the Court of Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Kayamkulam, which received the case on file as C.P.81/2017. Thereafter, procuring the presence of the accused and after complying with the formalities u/s.207 of Cr.P.C., the case was committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha u/s.209 of Cr.P.C. The Hon'ble Sessions Court made over the case to this Court for trial.

4. On appearance of the accused, after hearing both sides, charge u/s.302 of IPC framed, read over and explained to her, to which, she pleaded not guilty. Thereafter, on the side of the prosecution, PWs1 to 44 were examined and Exts.P1 to P66 were

marked. MO1 to MO18 were also marked. The contradictions in the 161 statement of PW9 were marked as Exts.D1 and D2.

5. After the close of prosecution evidence, the accused was questioned u/s.313(1)(b) of Cr.P.C, and she denied the prosecution case. The accused filed a separate statement contending that she is innocent. She has no connection with the death of Ajeesh. When Ajeesh tried to attack the husband of the accused, local people interfered, and during the scuffle, some how, he got injured which resulted in his death.

6. Thereafter, the accused was heard u/s.232 of Cr.P.C. As it is not a fit case to invoke Sec.232 of Cr.P.C., the accused was asked to enter upon her defence.

7. No defence evidence adduced.

8. Heard both sides and perused the records.

9. The points that arise for determination are:-

1. *Did the accused commit murder of Ajeesh, as alleged?*

2. *Sentence or order?*

10. **Point No.1**:- The prosecution case is that on 29.05.2017, at 07.30 p.m., the accused committed murder of her brother, Ajeesh due to the enmity that Ajeesh questioned the accused and her husband when they demanded back ₹1½ lakhs which was

borrowed by the friend of accused. The accused alleged to have stabbed behind the chest of Ajeesh with a knife, and he succumbed to the injuries.

11. The occurrence witnesses in this case PW1, a friend of the deceased Ajeesh, PW2, the person residing on the western side of the house of the accused, PW3, the wife of PW2, and PW4, the person residing on the eastern side of the house of accused, would say that there was some dispute in the family and there was an altercation on the alleged day. Some persons from outside also interfered and in the midst, the deceased was stabbed by someone. They did not see actually what had happened.

12. The other two occurrence witnesses who are close neighbours of the accused are PWs5 and 6. They did not support the prosecution case, and would say that they have not seen the alleged incident in which the deceased was stabbed by the accused.

13. One person who was examined as PW7, on the way to his friend's house, saw PW1 and the deceased sitting by the side side of a canal and the deceased was very tired and there was bleeding from his back. PW7 went to the nearest house and from the lady there, he collected a dhoti and the injury was tied tightly. He was told by PW1 that the deceased fell down from the motorcycle.

14. The entire incident was said to have started when PW8 did not repay the borrowed money to the accused. When she was examined, she totally denied all the said incident and she has also not supported the prosecution case in any manner.

15. After the incident, the deceased was immediately taken to the Government Hospital, Kayamkulam and he was examined by PW30, the Casualty Medical Officer. According to him, Ajeesh was brought to the Casualty at 07.55 p.m. on 29.05.2017 and there was heavy bleeding. He was going to shock and hence, he was immediately referred to the Medical College Hospital, Vandanam. Ajeesh was telling that he was stabbed. As it was not a proper time to write the wound certificate, no wound certificate was prepared at that time.

16. An ambulance driver who took Ajeesh to the Medical College Hospital, Vandanam, PW9 would say that Ajeesh was telling that his sister stabbed him, but his voice became feeble when the vehicle reached near the hospital, and at last, when he reached hospital, it was declared by the Doctor that Ajeesh is no more. In fact, he is the only witness who deposed that the accused was stabbed by his sister, but such a statement was not available in his 161 statement. So, the specific two versions were contradicted

and those contradictions, Exts.D1 and D2 were marked through the Investigating Officer, PW43.

17. PW1 went to the Police Station and gave Ext.P1 F.I. Statement. PW43, the Investigating Officer who was the Inspector of Police, Haripad in charge of the Inspector of Police Kayamkulam, took charge of the investigation on 30.05.2017 and at 10.45 a.m., he went to the Medical College Hospital, Vandanam, and prepared Ext.P3 inquest report. PW13 is the witness to inquest report. Thereafter, at 03.05 p.m. on the same day, Ext.P12 scene mahazar was prepared.

18. The accused was brought to the Police Station and she was arrested at 04.00 p.m. Exts.P46, 47 and 48 are the arrest memo, inspection memo and arrest notice respectively. The place of occurrence is the sit-out, courtyard and premises of house No.96. From the scene of occurrence, one pendent, ear-stud and one pair of slippers were seized, describing in scene mahazar, Ext.P12.

19. The accused was questioned and the confession extract is Ext.P2(a), and as per the same, the knife-MO6 was recovered and the recovery mahazar is Ext.P2. The witnesses to the recovery mahazar are PWs11 and 12. Thereafter, the clothes of the accused were seized as per the confession statement, and the clothes are

marked as MO2 series. The blood sample of the accused, her husband-CW6, CW61 and CW62 were taken and produced before the Court.

20. The accused was produced before the Court on 31.05.2017. The property list of MO6 kife is Ext.P49. According to PW43, MO6 was produced before the Court later and report, Ext.P57 filed to the effect that it was kept for further investigation. The property list of the number plate of the motorcycle is Ext.P50, and the property list with respect to the rubber mat of Wagon R car is Ext.P51 and those were produced before the Court. Ext.P52 is the forwarding note for sending the seized items to the Forensic Laboratory for examination.

21. After that, PW44 took over the investigation. He has seized the clothes of the deceased as per Ext.P6 seizure mahazar. The motorcycle used by the deceased and his friend, PW1 to reach the place of occurrence was seized by Ext.P8 seizure mahazar. The Wagon R car used for reaching the hospital was seized as per Ext.P9 seizure mahazar.

22. The accused and her husband reached the hospital immediately after the incident and they have also suffered some minor injuries.

23. PW34 is the Assistant Surgeon at Government Hospital, Kayamkulam who examined the patient Prasanth who is the husband of the accused at 08.55 p.m. and he was treated as Outpatient. The OP ticket is Ext.P25. On the same day, the accused was also examined and that OP ticket is Ext.P26.

24. The shirt as well as the dhoti of the deceased were seized by Ext.P10 seizure mahazar. The property list of the underwear of the deceased, a plastic bottle, ear-stud, sample packet, churidar of the accused, nail clippings of the accused, blood sample of the accused along with the nail clippings of the deceased and one tooth were produced before the Court in Ext.P58 property list. The sword-stick, one shirt and two dhoties were seized and produced before Court by describing in property list Ext.P59. Thereafter, he has taken steps for recording the 164 statements of CWs 2 to 5, 29 and 30.

25. The call detail records and connected documents, CD and video recorded at the time of inquest were produced in form 15, Ext.P60 before the Court. The call detail records and the customer application form were marked through PW42, the Alternate Nodal Officer, Vodafone-Idea, Kerala Circle. The call detail records of phone number 7560927883 is Ext.P39 and the 65

B certificate is Ext.P40. The subscriber details is Ext.P41 and the customer application forms are Ext.P42 series.

26. The call detail records of phone number 9947872564 is Ext.P35 and the 65B certificate is Ext.P36. The subscriber details is Ext.P37 and the customer application form is Ext.P38. The call detail records of phone number 7034606316 is Ext.P43 and the 65B certificate is Ext.P44. The prepaid customer application form is Ext.P45. These details are taken for the period from 01.01.2017 to 29.05.2017. Those were produced before the Court in Ext.P61 form 15.

27. The owner of the rented building where the accused was residing is PW10. She is not an occurrence witness. The clothes of the accused, MO3 series were seized describing in Ext.P4 seizure mahazar, and PW14 Civil Police Officer and PW15 Senior Woman Civil Police Officer of Kayamkulam Police are the witnesses.

28. PW16, the elder brother of the father of the deceased who was present at the time of inquest, received the body of deceased by executing Ext.P5 receipt. PW17, the person who is the signatory to the seizure mahazar of the same, Ext.P6 did not support the prosecution case. The rent deed was seized by Ext.P7 seizure mahazar and PW18 is the witness to the same.

29. The motorcycle KL-02-AB-1240 was seized describing in Ext.P8 seizure mahazar on 01.06.2017 at 10.30 a.m. The witness to the said mahazar is PW19, CPO, Kayamkulam Police Station. On the same day at 11.30 a.m., the car KL-62-3719 was seized describing in Ext.P9 seizure mahazar. On the same day, the clothes of the deceased were seized when the Police in the Aid Post of Medical College Hospital, Vandanam handed over the same, and that mahazar is Ext.P10.

30. The Scientific Officer later examined the vehicles on 03.06.2017 at 11.00 a.m. and the number plate of the motorcycle and the rubber mat of the car were seized, and the mahazar is Ext.P11. The shirt of the deceased is marked as MO4 and his dhoti is MO5.

31. The inquest report, Ext.P3 as well as the scene mahazar, Ext.P12 were written in the handwriting of PW20, CPO, Kayamkulam Police Station. PW21 is the CPO attached to the Aid Post of Medical College Hospital, Vandanam. According to him, when Ajeesh was brought to the hospital on 29.05.2017, at 7.45 p.m, he was no more. The clothes were taken into custody and handed over to the Investigating Officer.

32. The guard duty was done at the place of occurrence by PW22, CPO, Kayamkulam Police Station till the Scientific Officer,

Fingerprint Expert as well as the Photographer along with the Investigating Officer reached the place of occurrence. PW28 is the Assistant Photographer who took Ext.P18 photographs, 51 in number in seven sheets and the CD is Ext.P19 and the 65B certificate is Ext.P20. PW35 is the Scientific Expert attached to DCRB, Alappuzha, and she had collected samples from the place of occurrence, and that collection of evidence certificate is Ext.P27. She is the same person who collected samples from the motorcycle as well as car.

33. The Joint RTO, Kyamakulam-PW23 produced the RC particulars, Ext.P13 in respect of the Wagon R car KL-62-3719 and PW36, the Joint RTO, Kollam produced the RC particulars with respect to the motorcycle KL-2-AB-1240 and that is Ext.P25. PW38, the Motor Vehicle Inspector inspected the motorcycle as well as the car and the certificate is Ext.P30. No mechanical defects are noted.

34. The Assistant Engineer, PW24 working in Kayamkulam Electrical Section of KSEB produced Ext.P14 certificate showing that no complaint was received regarding the fact that there was no power supply failure at the time of occurrence in the premises of the place of occurrence.

35. The CPO, Kayamkulam PW26 had done the dead body guard duty from 11.30 p.m. on 29.05.2017 to 10.45 a.m. on 30.05.2017. Thereafter, the Investigating Officer prepared the inquest. The inquest was completed by 12.45 p.m., and at 01.20 p.m. the post mortem examination started and it was finished by 02.20 p.m. The postmortem examination was conducted by PW29. There was only a single ante-mortem injury. It was an incised penetrating wound and the post mortem certificate is Ext.P21. The ante-mortem injury is:

A gaping incised penetrating wound 3.5x0.8cm, horizontally oblique on the right side of back of chest, its inner upper blunt end, 6cm outer to midline and 30.5cm below the top of shoulder. The other end was sharp. The wound entered in to the chest cavity through the XIth inter costal space and transfixed the lower lobe of right lung 0.5cm above its lower border for a thickness of 0.8cm and was found penetrated in to the abdominal cavity after cutting the diaphragm 3.5x0.3cm, and punctured the right lobe of liver on its upper outer aspect producing a puncture wound 3.05x0.2x13cm and surrounding blood infiltration of 4.5x3x1cm and terminated in the substance of liver adjacent to hilum. Major vessels and its branches were cut and separated. The wound track was directed forwards, downwards and to the left for a total minimum depth of 21cm. Right chest cavity contained 350ml. of fluid blood. Peritoneal cavity was smeared with blood and 30ml fluid blood was seen on the posterior aspect of liver. It is

opined that death was due to incised penetrating wound sustained.

36. PW32 is an independent photographer who had taken video of the inquest. The CD is Ext.P22 and the 65B certificate is Ext.P23. The Assistant Secretary of Krishnapuram Grama Panchayath, PW33 issued Ext.P24 ownership certificate of the house where the incident took place.

37. PW39 is the Doctor who examined the accused on 31.05.2017 at 11 a.m., and the accused had five injuries, and that certificate is Ext.P31. Her blood grouping was done and that certificate is Ext.P32.

38. PW40, a camera man while proceeding towards his friend's house, saw blood stains on the bottle, slippers and in the frame of the door as well as window. There were marks of cut on the window as well as door. He is a witness to Ext.P12 scene mahazar.

39. PW41 is the Sub Inspector of Police, Kayamkulam who registered Ext.P33 F.I.R.on the basis of Ext.P1 F.I. Statement given by PW1. There was a mistake in the same which was corrected by Ext.P34 report. Thereafter, an express report was prepared and sent for the assistance of Scientific Officer, Photographer as well as

Fingerprint Expert. Since it was a grave crime, the investigation was handed over to PW43.

40. The sample was sent for chemical analysis and the report is Ext.P62. Five items were collected by the Scientific Officer from the vehicle and the certificate is Ext.P63. Four items of foot-wears were released to the husband of the accused on Ext.P64 kaichit. The motorcycle was released on Ext.P65 kaichit and the Wagon R car was released on Ext.P66 kaichit.

41. The empty water bottle is marked as MO9 and the underwear of the deceased is MO10. Nail clippings of both hands of accused are MO11 series. The remnants of the sample of blood collected by the Scientific Officer received from the Forensic Science Laboratory are MO12 series. Likewise, the nail clippings and tooth of the deceased returned from the lab is MO13. The ear stud is MO14. The remnants of blood sample of accused is MO15 and that of CW6, the husband of accused is MO16. The control sample of soil collected by the Scientific Officer is MO17 and it contained blood stained sand from the place of occurrence. The blood stained sand from the place of occurrence returned from lab is MO18.

42. In this case, the brother of the accused was died. The prosecution case is that when there was difference of opinion

between the accused and her brother along with the husband of the accused, the deceased went back from the rented house and thereafter took a sword-stick and came back and started attacking the accused as well as her husband. In the middle of the said attack, the accused stabbed the deceased from behind. There were so many persons available at the place of occurrence because it was not a sudden incident happened. There were verbal duel between the parties and it was in connection with the money borrowed from the accused by PW8 to whom the deceased had some affinity, and which provoked the deceased to pick up quarrel with his sister and husband, and thus, the incident took place.

43. The deceased had only a stab injury on the back of his body, but he did not get timely medical aid because it is evident that he went to the hospital by riding as a pillion on a motorcycle and on the way, he fell down and then, the injury was attempted to be dressed, and then reached the Government Hospital, Kayamkulam in an auto-rickshaw, and later he succumbed to the injuries on the way to the Medical College Hospital, Vandanam. It is true that the weapon of offence was recovered on the basis of the confession of the accused and that part of evidence is admissible under Sec.27 of Evidence Act. Even then, only on the basis of the said piece of evidence alone, liability cannot be

fastened upon the accused and that is laid down in the decision in **2025 Live Law (SC) 1106**.

44. None of the witnesses available at the place of occurrence supported the prosecution case. They have a case that there was a gathering and in the scuffle, some how, the accused was inflicted and injured. So, even though the prosecution attempted to prove the case by examining most of the material witnesses, it could be established that the accused has committed the offence alleged against her. Hence, these points are found against the prosecution.

45. **Point No.2:-**

In the result,

The accused is found not guilty of the offence punishable u/s.302 of the Indian Penal Code and hence, she is acquitted of the said offence, u/s.235(1) of Cr.P.C. The bail bond of the accused is cancelled and she is set at liberty forthwith.

MO1 and MO6 shall be broken up and confiscated, and MOs2 to 5 and 7 to 18 shall be destroyed, after the appeal period.
