This case coming on this day for hearing, the court passed  
the following:-

**ORDER**

This is a case arose on a final report submitted by the  
Sub Inspector, Nooranadu Police Station in Cr. No.485/2024  
alleging commission of offences punishable U/ss. 447, 294(b),  
326, 506(ii) IPC.

2. Prosecution case in brief is as follows: The accused is  
the neighbour of CW1, Retnakaran. The accused was conducting  
a welding and spray painting workshop near the house of CW1,  
which caused hardships to CW1 who was a cancer patient and  
hence he informed the matter to the ward member. Moreover, the  
functioning of the workshop in the evening caused voltage

fluctuations in the house of CW1 and hence he asked the accused to stop the work during evening time. Due to that enmity, the accused on 16.04.2024 at 08.00 pm, trespassed into the courtyard of Retnalayam House in Puthuppallikunnam Muri in Nooranadu Village, uttered obscene words and threatened CW1. Thereafter, the accused beat CW1, above his forehead with an iron pipe, causing fracture to the frontal bone. Hence the offences.

3. The accused was arrested and produced before court on 19.04.2024 and was released on bail on 10.05.2024 as per the order of the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha in CrI.M.P. 1724/2024 dated 10-05-2024. Upon taking cognizance, the case was taken on file as CC 245/2024. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused and after hearing both sides charge was framed, read over and explained to him to which he pleaded not guilty. Thereafter, the case was posted for evidence.

4. In the course of trial, it is submitted by the counsel for the accused that this case is the counter case of SC 1280/2024 pending before the Hon'ble Additional District and Sessions Court-III, Mavelikara and this case is to be tried along with that case. A report was called for from the Inspector SHO, Nooranad P.S and he reported that this case is the counter case of SC 1280/2024 (Nooranad Police Station Crime 486/2024). After hearing both sides and on perusal of records since it appeared that this case is one which ought to be tried along with SC 1280/2024 pending before the Hon'ble Additional District and

Sessions Court-III, Mavelikara, the case was re-numbered as CP. 10/2026, as per the order dated 09.03.2026 in CC 245/2024.

**5. Since this case is to be tried along with Sessions Case No. 1280/2024 which is pending before the Hon'ble Additional District and Sessions Court-III, Mavelikara,** case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha under section 323 Cr.P.C.

6. The case records shall be forwarded to the Hon'ble Sessions Court, Alappuzha and the property produced if any, shall be send subject to Rule 77(2) of the Criminal Rules of Practice, Kerala, as and when called for.

7. Notify the committal of the case to the learned Public Prosecutor, Alappuzha.
