

**MHSO050009672026 ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN CR. BAIL APPLICATION
488/2026**

**(Bajirao Sampati Yamgar Vs. The State of
Maharashtra)**

Present application is filed under section 483 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (B.N.S.S.) for regular bail to release the accused. Crime No. 570/2026 registered at Sangola Police Station.

2. Learned advocate for the applicant/accused submitted that, allegations made against this applicant that, he took the crop of Ganja in his agricultural land. Thereafter, police performed raid and around 9 k.g. in his agricultural land. Said quantity is below commercial quantity. Therefore, bar under Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act is not applicable to this case. This applicant is ready to follow all the conditions imposed by this Court. He is having agricultural land. Therefore, there are very less chance that, he would abscond. Hence, the application may be allowed.

3. Learned APP submitted that, the allegations made against this applicant are very grave. If this applicant is released on bail, there are chances that, he would create hurdle in the investigation. The investigation is still in progress. Hence, the application may be dismissed.

4. There is no dispute that, as per the prosecution around 8.342 k.g. Granja plants were recovered from the applicant. Admittedly said quantity is below commercial quantity. Therefore, there is no bar under Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act. Except this, police recovered nothing from this applicant. Also there is no prima facie material to come to the conclusion that, this applicant has committed same kind of offence. Since last one month, he is in jail. It means police got sufficient opportunity to carry out the investigation. All the witnesses are police witnesses therefore, there are very less chances that the applicant would put pressure on the witness.

In that situation, it is not necessary to keep this applicant in jail. Therefore, the applicant is entitled to be released on bail. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1 The bail application is allowed.
- 2 The accused be released on bail in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with surety in like amount.
- 3 The applicant shall attend the police station on every Wednesday in between 10.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. for the period of three months or till filing of charge-sheet whichever is earlier.
- 4 The applicant shall not pressure witnesses and create hurdle in the investigation.
- 5 The applicant shall not go out of jurisdiction of Pandharpur Court for the period of three months or till filing of chargesheet whichever is earlier.
6. The applicant shall give his mobile number to the Investigating officer so that the Investigating Officer could contact him as and when required.
