Reliefs sought : U/s.23(2) of the Protection of Women  
from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

Order : Partly allowed.

This case having been heard on 17.07.2025 and the court on the same day delivered the following:-

**O R D E R**

1. This is an application filed u/s 23(2) of the Protection of Women from Domestic violence Act, 2005 seeking interim orders.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners. Perused the records. On perusing the affidavit and petition, I am prima facie satisfied that there is likelihood that respondents may commit acts of domestic violence against the petitioners. I am also satisfied that the intervention of this court is highly necessary for the protection of the petitioners. Hence following ex parte interim order u/s 23(2) of the Act is passed.

1. The respondents are prohibited from committing any acts of domestic violence or from abetting the commission of acts of domestic violence against the petitioners, either physically or mentally.

2. The respondents are hereby restrained from making any obstruction to the peaceful residence of the petitioner in the shared house hold 'Kandathil house (Kuravan tharayil), Njakkanal P.O, Vayanakam, Oachira village, Karunagappally Taluk' and the petitioner's family house named 'Parambil puthan veedu, Mekkum muri, Thamarakulam village, Mavelikara Taluk'.

3. The respondents are further restrained from causing any obstruction to the working of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner in the Sree Narayana School, Pavumba.

Issue a copy of this order free of cost to the parties and officer in charge of police stations concerned.
