ORDER

This is a petition filed by the petitioner/plaintiff under Order
XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of CPC. For temporary prohibitory injunction.

Heard the learned counsel for petitioner and perused the affidavit as well as records.

I am satisfied that the petitioner has made out a prima facie case and if order of temporary injunction is not granted, irreparable injury is likely to be caused to the petitioner. If notice is ordered the object of granting temporary injunction would be defeated. Hence an order of interim injunction is passed restraining the respondent from trespassing into plaint A schedule property, felling the standing trees and interfering with plaintiff's peaceful possession and enjoyment until further orders.

The petitioner is directed to comply the Order XXXIX Rule 3(a). Issue interim injunction and notice. For return of notice to 12.07.2024.
