JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 269, of INDIAN PENAL CODE , U/ Sec 120(e) of Police Act, 1960 (Kerala) .

2. The Accused is present. Heard on framing charge. Charge framed u/s. 269 IPC and 120(e) of Police Act, 1960(Kerala) and read over to accused. Accused pleaded guilty.I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 120(e) of the Police Act, 1960 (Kerala) and Accused is sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment till the rising of the court. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 269, of the INDIAN PENAL CODE and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.2000/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
