**ORDER**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 15 of **Gaming Act, 1960** .

2. The Accused, A1 to A4, authorises counsel to plead guilty on their behalf by engaging vakalath. Plea accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice..

In the result, the Accused A1, A2, A3, A4 convicted for the offence punishable under Section 15 of the Gaming Act, 1960 and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.100/- each. In case of the default of the Accused A1, A2, A3, A4 in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 2 Days each.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
