Order : The case against the accused are committed to Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha u/s.232 of BNSS.

This case having been heard on today the court on the same day passed the following:-

**ORDER**

1. This case has arisen on a final report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, *Pulincunnu* Police Station against the accused person alleging commission of offences punishable U/ss. 296 (b), 351(2), 118(1), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190, 109 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).
2. **The prosecution case in brief is as follows:-** The informant – Harilal and other witnesses had jointly gone on a pleasure trip in the houseboat named “4 SIGHTS.” Due to a dispute that arose between the guests and the employees of the houseboat on account of the non-functioning of the air-conditioning system and microphone system in the said houseboat, accused Nos. 1 to 10, with the intention and premeditation to commit the murder of CW11 to CW3, unlawfully assembled to achieve their common object, armed with deadly weapons had on 13/01/2025 at about 9.15 PM, at Kainakary North Village, on the eastern side of the Kainakary Pamba River, the accused No. 10 boarded the said houseboat and created a commotion. Seeing this, as per the instructions of accused Nos. 1 and 2, accused No. 4 armed with a sword, accused No. 5 with an iron rod, accused No. 6 with a sword, accused No. 7 with a self-defence stick, accused No. 8 with a metal stick, and accused No. 9 with a steel rod, entered the houseboat. Accused Nos. 1 and 2, along with Accused Nos. 4 to 10 who reached the spot, jointly

threatened the witnesses by uttering obscene words. Thereafter, Accused No. 10 caught hold over the shirt of the informant. At that time, accused No. 2 shouted, to kill the witnesses. Then the accused No. 6 inflicted a sword blow on the head of CW 2, resulting in a grievous injury on the left frontal portion of his head, causing him to lose consciousness and fall down. While CW 2 was lying unconscious, accused No. 5 assaulted him with an iron rod, accused No. 6 with a sword, accused No. 7 with a self-defence stick, and accused No. 9 with a steel rod and caused further injuries. When CW 3 attempted to intervene, accused No. 6 assaulted him with the blunt side of the sword and accused No. 7 beat him with a self-defence stick, causing pain and injuries. When CW3 raised both hands to ward off the attack, accused No. 4 attempted to slash him on the head with a sword which was obstructed by the informant and then the blow hit his right hand, resulting in a cut injury between the thumb and index finger and on the palm of his right hand. If the said sword blow caused on CW3, it would have resulted in his death. Thereafter, accused No. 3, from outside the houseboat, abused CW1 and others using obscene words. Accused Nos. 1 to 10, together, hurled obscene words towards witnesses. Thereby the accused are alleged to have committed the offences punishable under sections U/ss. 296 (b), 351(2), 118(1), 189(2), 191(2), 191(3), 190, 109 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

3. On issue of summons accused persons appeared before the court, copies of all the relevant prosecution records were furnished to them u/s.230 of BNSS.
4. On perusal of the case records, it appears to me that the offences alleged against the accused persons are exclusively triable by the Sessions Court. Hence, the

case is to be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha. Therefore, the case is hereby committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha u/s. 232 of BNSS.

5. Issue notice to the Public Prosecutor. Notify him of the committal of the case and transmit records and material objects to the Hon'ble Sessions Court as per Rules.
6. The accused persons shall appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Alappuzha as and when required by that Court.
