This Criminal M.P coming on for hearing before me on 23.04.2024 and
the Court on the same day passed the following:

ORDER

This is an application filed by the 11th accused, Sri. N.Jayamurugan,
seeking permission to travel abroad.

2. The petitioner's case is that he is the 11th accused in the case. As
per the conditions in the bail in Crl.M.P. 34/2022 dated 01.10.2022 he was

directed to surrender his passport and not to leave India without the permission of this court.

3. The petitioner intends to travel to Bangkok on 25.04.2024 and return to Chennai on 29.04.2024 for business purposes. Copy of the travel itinerary are produced with the petition. The details of accommodation in Bangkok are also submitted with the petition. The petitioner seeks permission to travel abroad from 25.04.2024 to 29.04.2024.

4. I have heard the counsel for the petitioner and the Public Prosecutor.

5. The Public Prosecutor opposed the application stating that if the petitioner is permitted to go abroad, that may affect the trial of the case. The investigating officer filed report contending that there is no mention about the purpose of his visit to Bangkok. As the document filed by the petitioner is a copy, the petitioner may be directed to file a specific affidavit for confirming the authenticity and genuineness of the documents produced by him. The investigating officer insisted that if the petitioner is permitted to travel abroad, conditions may be imposed to secure the presence of accused.

6. The case is of the year 2018 and the petitioner is on bail for long time. The case is not ripe for trial. The petitioner wants to go abroad for 4 days for his business purpose. On hearing the counsel for the petitioner and the

learned Public Prosecutor and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, I am of the view that the petition can be allowed by imposing conditions.

In the result, the petition is allowed as follows:-

1. The petitioner/accused No.11 is permitted to visit Bangkok during the period from 25.04.2024 to 29.04.2024.
2. The petitioner shall appear before the court on next posting date, unless specifically exempted by the court.
3. If the petitioner violates the order, the sum of ₹1,00,000/- deposited by the petitioner as security shall be forfeited.
