- Offence : Punishable u/s 279 of I.P.C and 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V Act.
- Plea : Guilty
- Finding : Guilty
- Sentence or order : Accused is convicted u/s.252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- u/s.279 I.P.C and imprisonment till the rise of the Court u/s 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V. Act. In default of payment of fine the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 days.

This case having been finally heard on this day, the Court delivered the following:-

J U D G M E N T

The accused stands trial for the offence punishable under section 279 of I.P.C and 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V Act by the Sub Inspector of Police, Peermade Police Station, in Crime No.771/22.

2. Accused is present. Particulars of offences u/s.279 of I.P.C and 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V Act read over, explained to him to which he pleaded guilty. The plea is made voluntarily. Hence accused is found guilty of the offences u/s.279 of I.P.C and 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V Act and convicted thereunder.

3. In the result, accused is convicted u/s.252 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.1,000/- u/s.279 I.P.C and imprisonment till the rise of the Court u/s 3 (1) r/w 181 of M.V. Act. In default of payment of fine the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 days.
