This case having been heard on 04/06/2018 and the Court on the same day passed the following:-

ORDER

This is an application for conducting Test Identification Parade of A1. Heard. Learned Counsel for the accused submitted a written objection regarding lack of bonafide of the prosecuting agency. It is a matter to be considered during trial and at any rate at this stage, those objections can only be placed on record, but cannot be acted upon. Having regards to the facts of the case and nature of the offence, I find sufficient reasons to allow the application.

Hence, the 1st accused is directed to subject himself to identification by persons allegedly acquainted with the offence, at the jail premises. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Thrissur will nominate a Judicial Magistrate on requisition made by the Investigating officer.
