This petition filed under Order XXI, Rule 46 read with Sections 94(e) and 151 of CPC to prohibit, the 1st respondent from withdrawing and the 2nd

respondent from making payment of an amount of Rs.3,50,000/- from current account No.41590200001290 or such other account or deposits of the 1st respondent in that bank pending further orders from this court.

This petition is come up for hearing before me on 18.07.2025 and the court on same day passed the following:-

ORDER

This is an application filed under Order 38 Rule 5 of CPC 1908 seeking an order for the attachment before judgment of the defendants bank account maintained at Bank of Baroda, Chavakkad Branch, Adithiruthy, Kadappuram PO, Chavakkad, Thrissur District.

2. The petitioner has contended that the defendant is attempting to withdraw or conceal funds from the said account with intent to defeat the decree that may be passed in the suit. The affidavit filed in support of the petition and the materials placed on record disclosed a prima facie case for granting the relief.

3. On hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the records, this court is of the view that a conditional order of attachment is necessary to secure the ends of justice.

4. Accordingly, petition is allowed as follows:

The respondent is directed to furnish security for a sum of

Rs.2,47,041/- (Rupees two lakh fourty seven thousand and fourty one only) within thirty days to the satisfaction of the court, failing which the amount standing to the credit of the respondent current account number 41590200001290 is maintained with bank of Baroda, Chavakkad Branch shall be attached before judgment. 20.08.2025.
