ORDER

Heard the petitioners. Perused the copy of judgment of trial court. The judgment is supported by reasons prima facie. However petitioners as per the memorandum of appeal have made out an arguable case, veracity of which is to be decided on examining the trial court records. In the circumstance, the execution of sentence is suspended till disposal of appeal on the following conditions:-

1. Petitioners shall execute bond for ₹50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. Petitioners shall deposit 20% of the compensation amount before the trial court within 2 months from today.
