This petition filed to issue a No Objection Certificate in favour of the petitioner in order to facilitate his application process for obtaining an Indian Passport.

This Petition coming on for hearing before me on 12.11.2025 and the court on 17.11.2025 passed the following:-

**ORDER**

Petition to obtain No Objection Certificate.

2. Petitioner is the appellant in Criminal Appeal No.515/2024, which was filed against the judgment in S.C. No.216/2017 on the file of Principal Assistant Sessions Court, North Paravur, wherein he was the 5<sup>th</sup>

accused. He was convicted and sentenced under Sections 143, 147, 148, 323, 324, 326 and 308 r/w 149 of IPC. Petitioner preferred appeal under Sections 374(3) of Cr.P.C. Thereafter as per the order in Crl.M.P. No.2901/2024 dated 22.10.2024, this court suspended the sentence, pending disposal of the appeal. Now the petitioner request for permission of this court to obtain passport to seek overseas employment.

3. Notice given to the Public Prosecutor.

4. Objection filed.

5. Heard both sides.

6. Petitioner seeks overseas employment and hence possession of valid passport is essential. This case is of the year 2025. Considering the pendency of the cases, it is not likely that this case will be taken up for disposal within next one year. Considering the above facts, this petition can be allowed on conditions.

7. Hence, this petition is allowed in part on the following conditions:-

- 1) Petitioner shall execute bond for ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.

- 2) On execution of the bond as above, petitioner will stand permitted to leave India for a period of one year from 01.12.2025.
