This petition filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik  
Suraksha Sanhita 2023 (U/S 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure)  
to release the petitioner on bail

This Petition coming on for hearing before me on 18.10.2025  
and the court on 21.10.2025 passed the following:-

**ORDER**

Petition for bail filed under Section 483 of BNSS.

2. Petitioner is accused in S.C. No.1538/2024 on the file of this Court, arising out of Crime No.1152/2024 of Aluva East police station. The offence alleged is punishable under Section 103(1) of BNS.

3. The prosecution case, in brief, is that due to the previous enmity on account of the quarrel between the petitioner and the deceased Krishnankutty, on 03.07.2024 at 5.00 AM at Paravur Kavala in Thottakkattukara, petitioner committed murder of the deceased by stabbing him with scissors.

4. Notice given to Public Prosecutor.

5. Objection filed.

6. Heard both sides.

7. The offence alleged against the petitioner is of very grave nature. Investigation is over and final report is filed. There are

materials to prima facie make out the offence alleged against the petitioner.

8. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has been in custody for last more than 14 months, final report is filed and petitioner is entitled to bail at this stage. Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application.

9. Investigation in this case is over and final report is filed. The case stands scheduled for trial. There is no criminal antecedents reported against the petitioner. He has been in custody after his arrest on 03.07.2024. The objection raised by the prosecution is that if the petitioner is released on bail, he may abscond, influence or intimidate witnesses or commit similar offence while on bail. However, these objections can be met by imposing strict conditions on the petitioner. Considering the duration in custody, petitioner can be granted bail.

10. Hence, the petitioner is granted bail on the following conditions:-

- 1) Petitioner/accused shall execute bond for ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
- 2) The sureties shall produce copy of their title deeds and also make available original title deeds for verification to show that they have landed properties.
- 3) Petitioner shall surrender his passport. If he has no passport, he shall file an affidavit to that effect.
- 4) Petitioner shall not enter the limits of Aluva East Police Station till the conclusion of trial.
- 5) Petitioner shall not influence or intimidate witnesses.
- 6) Petitioner shall not involve in any offence while on bail.

- 7) If any of the condition is violated, bail granted is liable to be rejected.
