This petition having been heard today the court passed the following:-

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner/accused No.1 to give a no
Objection Certificate to passport authorities to for issuing fresh passport.

2. **Petition averments in brief:-** The petitioner herein is the 01st
accused in Crime No. 3506/2010 of Aluva East Police Station alleging offences
punishable under sections 379 and 465 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.
The petitioner herein possess a passport bearing No. C0155485, which is issued
on 22.07.2024 and with date of expiry on 21.07.2034. The petitioner's passport is
impounded under section 10 (3) (e) of the Passports Act, 1967, since he is an
accused in the above case. Hence the petition.

3. The Copy of the petition was served to learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and report was called for. The investigating officer filed report stating that if the passport of the petitioner is released, it may cause hindrance to the smooth progress of the prosecution and there is likelihood of absconding.

4. Heard both sides.

5. I have perused the records. On perusal of records, it would show that the petitioner is the accused No.1 in Aluva East Police Station Crime No. 3506/2010 (CC No.180/2013) and he was granted bail in this case. The offences alleged against the petitioner/accused No.1 are punishable under sections 379 and 465 r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. It would be harsh to deny the request of the petitioner/accused No.1 for issue fresh passport. This court is not in a position to direct the passport authority to issue a new passport. However, **this court has no objection** to issue new passport to the petitioner. In this situation I find it only just and reasonable to give a non objection for obtaining a new passport to the petitioner for a period of one year as per norms.

6. In the result, this petition stands allowed and the Regional Passport Officer is hereby informed that **this court has no objection** to issue a new passport to the petitioner/accused No. 1 in Aluva East Police Station Crime No. 3506/2010 for a period of one year as per norms. It is also

made clear that this permission is only for granting a passport and the petitioner shall not go abroad without the permission of this court.
