This case has been finally heard today and this Court passed the following:

ORDER

1. This is a bail application filed u/s. 480 of BNSS by the accused in Crime No.981/2025 of Chengamanad Police Station. The offences alleged against the accused are punishable under sections 126 (2), 118 (1), 109 (1) of BNS.
2. Prosecution case is that on 04.11.2025 at 4.15 pm, near MES Arts College, Kunnukara, the accused due to previous animosity towards CW1 and with intention to commit murder wrongfully restrained him while he was riding his scooter to Kunnukara Bhagom and stabbed him with a knife. When CW1 restrained the same, he sustained injuries inside the right palm. When he fall down, the accused stabbed on his back with the above

knife. Thereby the accused is alleged to have committed offences punishable under sections 126 (2), 118 (1), 109 (1) of BNS.

3. Petitioner has been in judicial custody since 05.11.2025. Heard. Report was filed by the Investigating officer opposing the bail application.
4. The allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. The involvement of petitioner in the crime is prima facie seen and there is nothing to suggest the innocence of the petitioner. The investigation is in progress. If the petitioner is enlarged on bail at this stage there is every chance for him to abscond, influence or intimidate witnesses and tamper with evidence affecting the investigation of the case. Hence, I am not inclined to allow the bail application and bail application stands dismissed.
