This case has been finally heard today and this Court passed the following:

ORDER

1. This is a bail application filed by the accused in Crime No. 2817/2025 of Aluva East Police Station. The offence alleged against the accused is punishable under section 74 of BNS.
2. The prosecution case is that on 29.12.2025 at 9.00 am at the rented house of the defacto complainant, the accused who is her son with intention to have sexual intercourse with her came from behind and hugged her and demanded for sexual favours. The accused thereby outraged her modesty. Thereby the accused is alleged to have committed offence punishable under section 74 of BNS.
3. The petitioner who is the accused in this case was arrested and produced before the court on 29.12.2025 and he was remanded to judicial custody on the same day.

4. Heard. Report was filed by the Investigating officer opposing the bail application.
5. The allegations levelled against the petitioner are serious in nature. The involvement of petitioner in the crime is prima facie seen and there is nothing to suggest the innocence of the petitioner. The investigation is in progress. If the petitioner is enlarged on bail at this stage there is every chance for him to abscond, intimidate or attack the witness and tamper with evidence affecting the investigation of the case. In this circumstances, this court is not inclined to grant bail to accused at this stage of the investigation. Hence, bail application stands dismissed.
