An application for grant of bail moved on behalf of accused Neeraj S/o Vijay Kumar.

Present:- Dr. Prayag Dutt Pandey, Ld. Substitute Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Rajesh Arora, Ld. Counsel for accused/applicant.

In the application, it is stated that the accused has been facing trial alongwith other accused persons and had been granted bail. It is further stated that accused has been appearing regularly and had never defaulted in appearance. It is further stated that accused had met with an accident and a rod had been inserted in his leg for which he is being medically treated. It is further stated that on 07.03.2025, as the counsel had not received any instructions from the accused, therefore, NBWs were issued against him. It is further stated that lateron, the counsel came to know that the accused was under medical treatment. It is, therefore, prayed that the accused be granted bail.

Ld. Addl. PP for the State has opposed the application on the ground that the accused has been involved in serious offence.

Heard.

Perusal of the record shows that the accused had been granted bail vide order dated 28.11.2018 passed by Ld. Predecessor and he had been regularly appearing before the court and has been

facing trial. It is further submitted on behalf of the accused that he is under medical treatment and could not appear on previous date of hearing.

Therefore, keeping in view the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, **accused is hereby admitted to bail in the sum of Rs.40,000/- with one surety surety of like amount subject to the satisfaction of Ld. JMFC/Duty JMFC/ link JMFC and subject to the following conditions:-**

1. The accused shall appear before the court on each date of hearing, unless specifically exempted.
2. the accused shall provide his permanent address and mobile number to the IO/SHO after his release and he shall keep the location setting 'on' of his mobile number at all times.
3. That he shall not commit any criminal offence/activity and shall not communicate with any of the witnesses.

Application stands disposed off accordingly.
