This petition coming upon for hearing on today's proceeding, the court passed the following:

**ORDER**

This is an application filed U/s.480 BNSS.

2. This is the Bail Application filed by the accused No.1 in Crime No. 2432/2025 registered by Muvattupuzha P.S. alleging offences punishable U/s. 262, 121 read with section 3(5) of BNS.
3. The petition averments, in brief, are as follows:- The petitioner submitted that he is innocent and has not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He is ready and willing to bailed by any condition that may be

imposed by this court. He has sufficient sureties to be produced before this court in order to secure his presence. Hence the petition.

4. Accused was arrested and produced before this court on 02.12.2025. Since, then he remains in judicial custody.

5. Heard.

7. The learned counsel for the accused submitted that he is innocent person and falsely implicated in this case. He is ready to abide any of the conditions imposed by this court.

8. Perused case records and connected prosecution materials. The accused has been in judicial custody from 02.12.2025. The investigation was already completed and police report was also filed. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and prevailing circumstances, the continued detention of the petitioner is unjust and improper. Hence, the bail application is allowed on the following conditions:-

1. The Petitioner/accused shall execute bond for Rs.25,000/-with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. The petitioner/accused shall not get involved in any offence of the same nature while on bail.
3. The petitioner/accused shall not try to influence or intimidate the witnesses while on bail.
4. The accused shall appear before the Court as and when required by the Court.
