**ORDER**

1. This is an application filed by the first accused in CC No: 511 of 2025 by seeking permission to renew passport. This case is charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Ramamangalam Police Station for the offences punishable under sections 406, 420, 34 of the IPC.
2. **The Petitioner's Case:-** The petitioner is the holder of an Indian Passport bearing No. E 8256884 which has been expired on 25.04.2014. The petitioner need to travel to Dubai for business and the petitioner intends to renew her passport. Due to the pendency of this case, the petitioner is unable to get the same and since the petitioner is the 1<sup>st</sup> accused in the case, she wants permission from the court to renew the passport. The petitioner is ready to abide by any condition of this court. Hence this application.
3. The copy of application served to the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.
4. Heard both sides.

5. On considering the contentions of both sides, this court is of the view that without any cogent cause it is not right to deny the petitioner to renew the passport from the authorities concerned. Hence, I am satisfied that the application can be allowed.

**In the result:-**

- a) The petitioner is permitted to apply before the authorities concerned for renewing the passport for a period of two years and the pendency of this case will not be a bar to issuing a passport to the petitioner.
- b) It is made clear that the petitioner shall appear before the court after obtaining passport and file affidavit regarding the same.
