This petition having been finally heard on 28 -10-2025 and the court on 31-10-2025 passed the following:-

**ORDER**

Petition for return of passport.

2. The case of the petitioner in short is as follows:-

He is the sole accused in the above case. The passport seized at the time of his arrest is in the custody of the

court. Validity of the passport has expired. He is a professional photographer engaged in imparting training for professional modelling. He has got a business opportunity in Dubai for imparting training and allied works. For the said purpose, he is required to travel to Dubai. Therefore it is necessary that passport is returned and he is granted permission to renew the same.

3. Report filed by the investigating officer to the effect that appropriate orders can be passed in the petition.

The only objection reported is that if the passport is returned, the petitioner may go aboard without appearing before the court for the proceedings.

4. Both sides were heard.

5. There is no dispute as to the fact that the passport has been seized by the investigating officer. There is also no dispute as to the fact that the validity of the passport is expired. If that be so, there is no reason as to why permission cannot be granted to renew the passport. I am satisfied that petition can be allowed.

**In the result.** the petition is allowed. The petitioner is permitted to renew the passport for a period of 3 years more. He shall surrender the new passport before this court, after renewal, immediately on receipt of the same.
