ORDER

This is an application filed by the petitioner u/s. 23 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Perused the affidavit and

relevant records. Petitioner has established a prima facie case of domestic violence against her and hence interim orders are necessary. Delay in notice may defeat the purpose of granting an interim order. In the result, the following ad-interim orders are passed:

1. The respondents are restrained from committing any sort of domestic violence against the petitioner as provided u/s.18 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act.

Issue Copy of order to Station House Officer, Hill Palace Police Station, Station House Officer shall take necessary action when any genuine case of domestic violence is reported. Intimate order to Women Protection Officer.
