**ORDER**

1. The Case stands charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Njarakkal Police Station in Crime No.937/21 of Njarakkal P.S against A-1 and A-2 alleging commission of offences punishable U/Ss.370(1),370(2) r/w 34 of Indian Penal Code.
2. **The prosecution case in brief as follows:** The accused, in furtherance of their common intention to take CW1 to a foreign country and arrange her for sexual exploitation and thereby obtain unlawful gain, induced CW1 by making false and alluring representations that she would be provided employment in Qatar for taking care of children for four hours a day, with free accommodation, free food and a monthly salary of ₹23,000/-. Believing the representations made by the first accused, CW1 agreed to travel abroad. Pursuant thereto, the second accused arranged domestic employment for CW1 in the house of one Seena Saleem Anhari at Doha, Qatar. Thereafter, CW1 travelled from Cochin International Airport to Doha on 04.03.2020 on a visiting visa bearing No. VC20210586 using Passport No. U5185280 issued by the Government of India, and arrived in Doha on 05.03.2020. CW1 remained in Qatar and subsequently departed from Qatar on 08.07.2021 and arrived at Cochin International Airport on 09.07.2021. The travel records of CW1 establish that she had travelled from Cochin to Doha and thereafter returned from Doha to Cochin during the aforesaid period. The accused committed the offences punishable under Sections 370 (1), 370(2) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. During the investigation, A-1 was granted anticipatory bail by the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala vide order dated 28.10.2021 in Bail Application No. 6474/2021. Pursuant to the order of anticipatory bail granted, the accused appeared before this Court on 02.11.2021 and executed a bail bond to the satisfaction of this Court.

4. After taking cognizance of the offences, this Court took the case on file as the afore CP. On service of summons, the first accused appeared before this Court on 30.05.2024. He filed a memo seeking permission to continue the bail bond executed by him during the crime stage pursuant to the order of anticipatory bail. The request was allowed and the bail already executed was permitted to continue .The second accused appeared before this Court on 03.03.2026 in response to the summons issued by this Court. He was enlarged on bail on executing the requisite bond to the satisfaction of this Court. Copies of relevant prosecution records were served to both the accused U/s.230 of BNSS.
5. As the offence U/s. 370 of IPC is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions, the case is committed for trial to the Hon'ble Principal Sessions Court, Ernakulam U/s.232 of BNSS.
6. Forward the case records forthwith and material objects, if any, as and when an intimation is received from Hon'ble Sessions Court. Notify the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor about the committal of the case to the Hon'ble Principal Sessions Court, Ernakulam .
