COMMON ORDER

These are petitions filed by the learned Special Public Prosecutor seeking examination of three witnesses through Electronic Video Linkage.

2. Crl.MP 01/2026 is filed for examination of CW11 who is a doctor who conducted medical examination of the survivor. Crl.MP 02/2026 is filed for examination of CW15, the Secretary of Meenangadi Grama panchayath who issued birth certificate of the survivor. Crl.MP 04/2026 is filed for examination of CW3, who is the Psycho Social Councilor of the school in which the survivor was studying.

3. When the matter came up for consideration, the learned defence counsel raised only a formal objection. The petitions therefore stand allowed. The witness CW11 shall be examined from the hospital where the said doctor is working.

4. CW3 will appear before the District Legal Service Authority, Kozhikode for evidence on the time of date fixed.

5. CW15 will appear before the District Legal Service Authority, Wyanad on the time and date fixed. On these conditions, all the petitions stand allowed.

6. In the result, all the petitions are allowed. The office shall address the Hon'ble Principal District Judges, Kozhikode and Wayanad in accordance with Electronic Video Linkage Rules, 2025.
