This Petition filed U/s. 430 of BNSS 2023 with a prayer to suspend the execution of the sentence passed against the petitioners/appellants in C.C.No.802/2015 of the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court- I, Peermade and coming on for hearing before me on 09.07.2025 in the presence of the above counsel and the Court on the same day passed the following:

ORDER

Heard the counsel for the petitioners/appellants. Perused the memorandum of appeal and documents appended therewith. It appears that the petitioners/appellants are having an arguable case and hence, this appeal is admitted. Therefore impugned sentence is suspended on appellant executing each bond for ₹50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial court and subject to deposit ₹10,000/- as part of the fine amount within one month from the date of this order.
