JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 15(c) of **Abkari Act** .

2. The A1 is absent. Accused pleaded guilty through counsel to the charge framed for the above said offence. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused A1 convicted for the offence punishable under Section 15(c) of the Abkari Act and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/-. In case of the default of the Accused A1 in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 1 Day.

Case against remaining accused A2 is refiled with Registration No:ST 739/2026.
