ORDER

The application is filed under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 of CPC, 1908 with a prayer for temporary injunction.

2. Heard the counsel for petitioners/plaintiffs.

3. Perused the affidavit, plaint and documents. I am satisfied that, a prima facie case has been made out and issuing notice would delay and defeat the very purpose of granting injunction. Hence, an ad-interim injunction is granted restraining the respondents/defendants and men under them from trespassing in to the plaint A and B schedule properties or from destroying the boundary of the B schedule property or from committing any act of waste in the plaint A and B schedule properties and from doing any act detrimental to the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the plaint A and B schedule properties by the plaintiffs/petitioners until further orders.
