Charge	Bail application is allowed.

This petition came for hearing on 09/07/2025 in the presence of the above counsel for both sides and the Court today passed the following:

**ORDER**

- 1) This is the bail application filed by the learned counsel for the accused u/s.480 of BNSS.
- 2) The petitioner submits as follows:- He is innocent in the case. If he is released on bail he will attend at the place and time as directed by this court. Hence, it is prayed that bail may be granted to the petitioner.

- 3) Notice was given to the learned Special Public Prosecutor and report was also called from SHO, Peermade Police Station.
- 4) The Police Inspector, Peermade Police Station filed objection stating as follows:- If the petitioner is released on bail, there is chances that he will threaten and influence the witnesses. As the petitioner and victim are neighbours, the release of the accused on bail will create tension in the locality. There is also chance that he will abscond. Hence, it is prayed that the petition may be dismissed.
- 5) Heard both sides and perused the materials on record. The prosecution case is that 06.02.25 at 10.30 p.m, the accused criminally trespassed into the bedroom of the house of the victim, aged 14 years, and committed penetrative sexual assault on her. Thereby the accused alleged to have committed offences punishable u/s.332(B), 64, 65(1) of BNS 2023, s.3(a) r/w s. 4(1), 4(2) of POCSO Act.
- 6) Heard both sides and perused the materials on record. The petitioner/ accused has been in judicial custody since 12/02/2025. The case records shows that he is the immediate neighbour of the victim. Considering the period of judicial custody already undergone by the accused and his young age, I am inclined to grant bail to the accused subject to conditions. Hence bail is granted to the accused on executing bond for Rs.50,000/- with two solvent sureties for the like sum subject to the following conditions that:-
  1. The accused shall not enter Elappara village till the conclusion of the trial in this case.
  2. The accused shall not in any way contact or communicate, either directly or or through eletronic means with the victim.

3. The accused shall not threaten or influence the witnesses including the victim or tamper with the evidence in the case.

Communicate the order to the Jail Superintendent concerned and to SHO, Peermade.
