These petitions coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri.Aslam Pareth, Advocate for petitioners in all Crl.MPs; of Sri. P. Satheeshan, Addl.Public Prosecutor for respondent (State) in all Crl.MPs and the Court passed the following:

COMMON ORDER

These petition are filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, on behalf of the petitioners/accused for regular bail.

2. **The case of the petitioners in brief is as follows:-** The first petitioner is the accused number 4 in SC No.119/2025, accused number 5 in SC No.29/2025 and

accused number 9 in SC No.121/2025. The second petitioner is the accused number 12 in SC No.119/2025 and accused number 13 in SC No.121/2025 & SC No.29/2025. It is stated that the petitioners are innocent and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the respondent/complainant. This court issued summons to the petitioners/accused. Hence, the petitioners have appeared before this court with solvent sureties and filed the present applications for regular bail.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The point for consideration is:-

1) "Are the petitioners entitled to be released on bail"?

5. **The Point:-** The final report in the case has been filed before this court and this court has already taken cognizance of the offence. Given the facts and circumstances of the case, this court holds the view that bail can be granted to the petitioners with conditions to ensure their presence during trial.

As a result, these petitions are **allowed** as follows.

1. The petitioners/accused shall be released on bail on their executing bond for ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with two solvent sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Court.

2. The petitioners/ accused shall not commit a similar offence while on bail.
3. The petitioners/accused shall not intimidate, influence or try to contact the prosecution witnesses.
4. The petitioners/accused shall only leave India, with prior permission of the court, till the trial is over.
5. The petitioners/accused shall regularly remain present during the trial, and cooperate with the Court to complete the trial for the above offences.
