Petition filed by the petitioner to release the passport and permission to renew his passport for a period of two years.

Both these petition are coming on 28th day of January, 2026 for final hearing before me in the presence of Sri.Samsuddeen B.K, Advocate for the Petitioner in both Crl.MPs; of Sri.Chandramohan.G, Additional Public Prosecutor-II for the Respondent (State) in both Crl.MPs; and having stood over to this day for consideration; the Court passed the following:

ORDER

The first and second applications cited above have been filed by the second and first accused persons respectively.

2. Crl.M.P.No.1/2026 has been filed by accused No.2 praying to release his Passport bearing No.S8924395 to him and for permitting him to go abroad for attending Umrah.

3. Crl.M.P.No.2/2026 has been filed by accused No.1 praying to release his Passport bearing No.N2090663 to him and for permission to renew his passport for a period of two years.

4. According to the first accused, the validity of his Passport which was deposited in the compliance of bail order dated 16.05.2025 in Crl.M.P.No.820/2025 expired on 30.08.2025. The same is to be released to him for getting the same renewed and for the said purpose, release of the said Passport is also highly necessary. Hence, Crl.M.P.No.2/2026 has been filed.

5. According to the second accused, his Passport was also surrendered before the court in compliance of bail order dated 16.05.2025 in

Crl.M.P.No.820/2025. Accused No.2 is desirous of performing Umrah pilgrimage and hence, it is highly necessary that the said Passport be released to him and he be permitted to leave India. Hence, Crl.M.P.No.1/2026 has been filed.

6. The Station House Officer filed common report opposing the applications and the Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposes the applications. According to the prosecution, the accused persons have been charge sheeted for commission of offence punishable U/ss.22(b) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act after they were found to have been illegally transporting 2.380 Grams of MDMA for the purpose of sale in motor car bearing registration No.KL 14W 7803 at 4.30 PM on 10.03.2025 at Muriyanavi. According to the prosecution, accused No.2 is also allegedly involved in Crime Nos.441/2022 and 485/2022 wherein he is alleged to have committed offences of the like nature. According to the prosecution, if the petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 2 are granted the reliefs which they have prayed for, they are likely to escape from India, screen themselves from justice and thereby protract the expeditious disposal of the matter. The prosecution prays for dismissal of the applications.

7. It is pertinent to note that, the case is only of the year 2025 and the trial of the case is yet to commence. Accused No.1 has only sought for release of his Passport for renewing the same for a limited period of two years and issuance of No Objection Certificate for such renewal. Accused No.2 has only sought

permission to leave India for the limited purpose of attending Umrah Pilgrimage and release of his Passport to him for the said purpose.

8. I am satisfied that the said reliefs can be allowed for a limited period expiring on 31.05.2026 and subject to conditions which are sufficient to address the apprehensions raised by the prosecution.

In the result, the following order is passed;

Crl.M.P No.01/2026 is allowed in part, subject to the following conditions;

- a) The Passport bearing **No.S8924395** of the petitioner/accused No.2 shall be released to him for a limited period which expires on 31.05.2026 and permission is granted to the petitioner/accused No.2 to leave India till 31.05.2026 for the limited purpose of attending Umrah.
- b) The petitioner/accused No.2 shall return to India on or before 31.05.2026 and he shall surrender the Passport back to this court on or before 05.06.2026.
- c) The petitioner shall file affidavit to the above effect.
- d) The petitioner/accused No.2 shall execute a bond for ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each with two solvent sureties each for the like sum undertaking to comply with condition Nos.(a) and (b) above.

Crl.M.P No.02/2026 is allowed in part, subject to the following conditions;

- a) It is directed that the Passport bearing **No.N2090663** shall be released to the petitioner/accused No.1 till 31.05.2026 for the mere purpose of renewing the same.
- b) No Objection Certificate is granted intimating the Passport Authority concerned that this court has no objection in renewing the Passport of the petitioner/accused No.1 bearing No. **N2090663** for a limited period of two years from today.
- c) The petitioner/accused No.1 is directed not to leave India without the permission in writing of this court.
- d) The petitioner/accused No.1 shall execute bond for ₹50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) each with two solvent sureties each for the like sum undertaking to abide by conditions (a) to (c) mentioned above.
