2. At the hearing, Mr.Shafi.M, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/ appellant argued that the appellant has got good ground to contest the matter in the appeal. He therefore prays for suspension of impugned order and sentence imposed upon the appellant by the Juvenile Justice Board, Kasaragod as per the impugned judgment.

3. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of sentence imposed, I am of the view that the execution of sentence imposed upon the appellant is liable to be suspended until further orders. I order accordingly.

In the result, the execution of impugned order and sentence against the petitioner/appellant in CC No.06/2019 on the file of the Juvenile Justice

Board, Kasaragod stands suspended on his executing a bond for ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with a solvent surety for the like sum, on or before 20.09.2025.
