ORDER

This is a petition filed under section 23 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the Act.)

2. Perused the petition, affidavit and documents.

3. Heard. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the respondents committed domestic violence on the petitioner and they are interfering with the peaceful life of the petitioner. It is also submitted that the respondents are trying to alienate the petition schedule property. The said acts are to be prohibited. Hence, the petition.

4. I have perused the records. From the affidavit and the petition, it is prima facie disclosed that the respondents have committed domestic violence. It is satisfied that the issuance of notice at this stage would defeat the object of granting this order by delay and would cause irreparable loss and injuries to the petitioner. Hence, an ad-interim exparte order is passed

in the following lines until further orders:

1. *The respondents are hereby prohibited from committing any sort of physical, emotional or verbal abuse on the petitioner especially by communicating the petitioner through mobile phone or any other electronic devices.*
2. *The respondents are hereby prohibited from alienating the petition schedule property.*
3. *The S.H.O concerned shall assist the petitioner in implementing direction No. 1 in this order on a written petition filed by the petitioner in this behalf.*
4. *Intimate this order to the Village Officer and Sub Registrar Officer concerned.*
5. *Issue emergent notice to the respondent to appear on 05.06.2026.*
