ORDER

1. This case has been instituted on the police report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police in Thamarassery Police Station Crime No.91/2025, alleging that the accused are committed offences punishable under Sections U/ss. 189(2),191(2),191(3),126(2), 115(2),118(1),110,190 of BNS, 2023.

2. The prosecution case, in brief, as stated in the police report/charge sheet, is as follows: On 26.01.2025 at about 10:00 p.m., at Thettampuram, accused Nos.1 to 7, being members of an unlawful assembly, wrongfully restrained CW1 and his friend. The 1st accused slapped CW1 on his face and stabbed him on his abdomen and chest with an iron weapon. When CW1 fell to the ground, the 1st accused again attempted to stab him on his head with the same iron weapon. Had CW1 not moved away, the blow would have struck his head and might have even caused his death. When CW2 attempted to intervene, he was also beaten and kicked by the accused, thereby causing him injuries. Thus, the accused committed the offences alleged.

3. Upon receipt of the police report, cognizance was taken of the offences alleged. The case was taken on file as C.P. No. 3/2026. The accused No.1 did not appear and is absconding. Upon the appearance of the accused Nos.2 to 7, copies of the prosecution records were furnished to them in compliance with Section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. They are on bail.

4. Heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and the learned counsel for the accused. Perused the prosecution records.

Since the offences punishable under Section 110 of the BNS is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Session, the case is liable to be committed for trial. Accordingly, the following orders are passed:

1. The case against accused Nos.2 to 7 is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court u/s.232 of the BNSS.
2. Send to the Hon'ble Sessions Court the record of the case and the documents and articles, if any, which are to be produced in evidence.
3. Notify the Public Prosecutor of the commitment of the case.
4. The accused Nos.2 to 7 are directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when directed.
5. The case against accused No.1 is split up and refiled as CP 16/26.
