Status report by way of reply filed. Counsel for petitioners has pointed out that in compliance of order dated 02.11.2021, petitioners have already joined the investigation and fully co-operated with the investigating officer. Therefore, it was prayed that interim bail may kindly be made absolute. The factum of petitioners having joined the investigation, has not been disputed by ld. P.P. for the State.

Admittedly, in compliance of order dated 02.11.2021, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and apparently custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. Moreover, it is a question of debate as to whether the alleged offence is made out against the petitioners or not especially when there is unexplained delay in lodging present FIR and a separate complaint against the real culprit is already pending. Hence, in view of facts detailed above, without commenting on the merits of the case, interim bail order dated 02.11.2021, passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute. Resultantly, the petitioners be released on bail in the event of their arrest, on furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of arresting/Investigating Officer/SHO

concerned. Needless to mention here that petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation and shall join the investigation as and when called for and shall not intimidate or tamper with prosecution evidence. Petitioners shall not leave India without permission of Area Magistrate. In case, petitioners would make an attempt to tamper with prosecution evidence or intimidate the witnesses, then prosecution would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of their bail. Let, a copy of this order be sent to the SHO/IO concerned for information. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
