**JUDGMENT**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 128(1) r/w 194C of **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** , U/Sec 281 of **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** .

2. The Accused is absent. Accused pleaded guilty through counsel to the charge framed for the above said offence. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 128(1) r/w 194C of the **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 3 Days. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of the **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 3 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
