J U D G M E N T

This case is instituted upon the final report filed by the Excise Inspector, Excise Range Office, Thamarassery, alleging offences punishable u/Ss.20(b) ii (A) of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

2. Accused absent, represented. Counsel filed application to permit him to plead guilty on behalf of accused. Application is allowed. Copies of all relevant prosecution records are furnished to counsel. Particulars of the offences is read over and explained, to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntarily. The accused is found guilty. He is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.7,500/- for the offence punishable u/S.20(b) ii (A) of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for one month.

3. The property produced and registered as item No.1 in PR No.477/2024 shall be directed to be disposed off according to law after appeal period.
