ORDER

1. This case has been instituted on the police report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police in Thamarassery Police Station Crime No.608/2025, alleging that the accused committed offences punishable under Sections 118(1) and 110 of the BNS.

2. The prosecution case, in brief, as stated in the final report/charge sheet, is as follows: On 16.06.2025 at about 9:30 PM, at Theyyaparakunnu, inside the dining hall of the house bearing No.13/375B of Puthuppadi Grama Panchayat, the accused abused CW2. When CW1 questioned the same, the accused, who is the father of CW1, out of enmity, attempted to stab CW1 on his abdomen with a knife. CW1 evaded the attack, and the stab instead landed on his left thigh, causing injury. Had CW1 not moved away, the stab would have hit

his abdomen and could have resulted in death. Thus, the accused committed the offences punishable under Sections 118(1) and 110 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. Upon receipt of the police report, cognizance was taken of the offences alleged. The case was taken on file as C.P. No. 5/2026. Upon the appearance of the accused, copies of the prosecution records were furnished to him in compliance with Section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. The accused is on bail.

4. Heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and the learned counsel for the accused. Perused the prosecution records. Since the offence punishable under Section 110 of the BNS is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Session, the case is liable to be committed for trial. Accordingly, the following orders are passed:

1. The case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court u/s.232 of the BNSS.
2. Send to the Hon'ble Sessions Court the record of the case and the documents and articles, if any, which are to be produced in evidence.
3. Notify the Public Prosecutor of the commitment of the case.
4. The accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when directed.
