ORDER

1. This case has been instituted on the police report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Thamarassery Police Station, in Crime No.753/2025, alleging commission of offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1) and 110 of the BNS.

2. The prosecution's case in brief, as stated in the police report/charge sheet, is as follows: On 28.07.2025 at about 12.00 noon, at the house named Puzhamkunnummal in Kaithapoyil, the accused, who is the son of CW1, wrongfully restrained her, assaulted her on the head and face, and attempted to stab her on the neck with a knife. CW1

warded off the blow with her hand; otherwise, the stab would have struck her neck and could have caused her death. The motive for the incident was the grudge borne by the accused over CW1's refusal to give him a sum of ₹1,00,000/- as demanded by him. Thus, the accused committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Upon receipt of the police report, cognizance was taken of the offences alleged. The case was taken on file as C.P. No. 8/2026. On the appearance of the accused, copies of the prosecution records were furnished to him in compliance with Section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. The accused is on bail.

4. Heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor and the learned counsel for the accused. Perused the prosecution records. Since the offence punishable under Section 110 of the BNS is exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Sessions Court, the case is liable to be committed for trial. Accordingly, the following orders are passed:

1. The case is committed to the Hon'ble Sessions Court u/s.232 of the BNSS.
2. Send to the Hon'ble Sessions Court the record of the case and the documents and articles, if any, which are to be produced in evidence.
3. Notify the Public Prosecutor of the commitment of the case.
4. The accused is directed to appear before the Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when directed.
