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This Petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri. P. Prasanth, and Sri. Aswanth, Advocates for Petitioners and Sri. Razal Rahman and Sri. Anand Thomas, Advocates for Respondent Nos. 1, 4 & 5 and Respondent No. 2 not entered in appearance and Respondent No. 3 *ex parte* and the Court passed the following:

ORDER

1. Petition filed under Order 39 Rule 1 of Code of Civil Procedure.
2. Petitioner represented. Respondent Nos. 1, 4 & 5 represented. Counsel for Petitioner submitted that steps could not be taken against Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 as there was no order to pay batta. On perusing the Petition and the proceeding sheet it is found that the order of injunction allowed till 25.03.2025 was not extended. Counsel for Petitioner submitted that irreparable injury will be caused to the Petitioner if the order is not extended. The Order of injunction was not extended as no steps were taken against Respondent Nos. 2 and 3. Therefore in the interest of justice till the disposal of the application the Respondents are directed not to trespass into petition schedule property or to cause damage to petition schedule property. Respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5 filed counter. For return of notice to Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 via process server- 20.12.2025.
