JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable u/Sec 281 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita & u/Sec 128, 194C of MOTOR VEHICLES ACT.

2. Matter suo moto advanced. Accused is absent. Applied with vakalath. Appeared through counsel. Copy furnished. Plea read over and explained through the counsel appearing for the accused. Accused pleaded guilty through his counsel. He is informed of the consequence and he stuck to his plea. Found guilty. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, Accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita & u/Sec 128, 194C of MOTOR VEHICLES ACT. He is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,000/- u/Sec 194 C of MV Act. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 Days. He is also sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.500/- u/Sec 281 of BNS. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
