This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri.K.K. Ratheesh Kumar, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Sri. P.P. Rajan, Advocate for the respondents and this court passed the following.

**ORDER**

This petition filed under Order XXI Rule 37 and 38 r/w Section 55 and 151 of the code of Civil Procedure 1908.

Decree Holder represented. Judgment Debtors represented. Judgment Debtors paid Rs.10,000/- towards decree debt. Endorsed on EP. Judgment Debtors already filed affidavit stating that they are ready to clear off the decree debt by paying Rs.5,000/- per month. This court has gone through the proceedings sheet. It is revealed that the Judgment Debtors are regularly effecting payments, especially more payments through the court. Decree Holder is also amenable for the affidavit filed by the Judgment Debtors. Since, Judgment Debtors are effecting payments through the court the EP is closed for the time being and the Decree Holder can revive the EP at any stage when the Judgment Debtors make any default in payment. EP is closed for the time being.
