ORDER

Accused present. CW1 present. Examined as PW1. PW1, who is entitled to compound the offences alleged, which are compoundable, had compounded the same. From the statement, I am satisfied that same was done voluntarily. Hence the compounding is accepted. The composition of the offences will have the effect of acquittal of the accused u/S 320 (8) Cr.P.C. Hence the accused is acquitted u/S. 320 (8) of Cr.P.C. and the accused is set at liberty. His bail bond stands cancelled.
