Satpal Singh Vs State Of Punjab

ORDER

In continuation of order dated 31.05.2023, further arguments heard.

It was submitted by the prosecution that petitioners have joined the investigation but the dowry articles i.e. gents kantha, gents kara, ring, pendent, diamond ring, gold ear rings are yet to be recovered. They were handed over to the petitioners Satpal Singh, Gurjeet Singh and Rajinder Kaur etc between 31.05.2018 to 04.06.2018. The family of the bridegroom went to Canada for solemnizing the marriage while family of bride did not go to Canada. These articles are to be recovered from the petitioners.

On the other hand, Ld counsel for the petitioners submitted that both the parties solemnized the marriage in Canada and took divorce by mutual consent in Canada. Even petitioner Rajinder Kaur was not in India during 31.05.2018 to 04.06.2018 as per the certified copy of passport placed on file, which falsify the case of the prosecution.

It was further submitted by the prosecution that however the divorce was by way of mutual consent but it was agreed upon between the parties in writing that matter regarding dowry articles would be settled later on. For producing the writing to come upon, 03.07.2023. Interim order is extended till then.
